DEPOSITS

When a permit is issued, a deposit payable to the Road Commission, in the form of an **Certified Check, Irrevocable Bank Letter of Credit, or Bond (as determined by the Clinton County Road Commission Managing Director)** will be required to guarantee payment of damages to roadway(s) for "above normal:" maintenance work and minor improvements necessitated by the Permittees's operations. The deposit, minus any charges and inspection fees, will be refunded at the expiration of the permit after the haul route has been inspected, and any necessary repairs have been made. This will be a minimum of 10 days after haul is completed, giving the commission sufficient time to evaluate any possible damage to the haul route and perform necessary repairs.
